

## Baseball FAQ's

### Season

- Begins with afternoon practices on the Monday preceding January 15 and run through on or around last week in April, not including playoffs. A break will be taken at Spring Break (Mon-Sun) and Easter Weekend (Fri-Sun).
- The season may consist of 20 to 22 regular season games and 1 tournament. Traveling and home games will be as close to a 50/50 split as practicable.
- Schedules are made with traditional rival schools and other schools both UIL and TAPPS that are of about equal levels of competition for our squads.
- Most baseball games will begin at 4:00pm, both home and road. It is the goal of the athletic department to stick to a Tuesday and/or Friday game schedule if at all possible.
- Due to the lack of a field on campus, Logos Preparatory Academy must arrange for home games to be held at an area facility willing to accommodate such an event. In the past, games have been held at Sugar Land Major League Field.
- The Athletic Department will do its best to secure a practice and game facility for baseball that will not add additional costs to parents for the sport.
- Requires at least 12 athletes to field a team.

### Practice Times and Locations

- Practice time will be Monday through Friday from 3:30pm to 5:30pm. The Coach reserves the right to adjust the length of practice (up or down) based upon conditioning and performance. Any changes to the schedule will be communicated to the families in writing in advance of the change.
- Practices will be held at Sugar Land Major League Field.

### Fixed Costs

- Baseball will have a fixed course fee and material fee that must be paid through the school. Since this fee will be evaluated on a year to year basis, please contact the offices of Logos Preparatory Academy for current fee schedule.

- Fixed costs go toward the Coaches pay, game equipment, practice equipment, traveling expenses, uniforms, officiating expenses, facilities fees (including memberships), and first aid supplies.

### **Equipment Provided**

As a part of the fixed costs items, the following equipment will be provided to each athlete for the duration of the basketball season. Unless otherwise stated, this equipment remains the possession of Logos Preparatory Academy and must be returned upon completion of the season or upon departure from the team.

- Uniform and Pants, practice balls, batting helmets, game balls, a hat, belt, and socks.

### **Equipment Not Provided**

- Shoes, towels, practice clothes.

### **Other Costs**

- Parents are advised that the team will stop and eat a meal after a road game. This location is usually at a sit-down type of establishment with a cost of \$5-\$10 for the meal. It is the student's responsibility to pay for these meals or bring a sack lunch.
- Students are responsible for getting a complete athletic physical before the first day of practice. The cost of this varies according to the Doctor you use. Physical forms are available at the school. If the student already has a physical from the same calendar year for another event or organization, a copy of the physical is acceptable.
